

SEPTEMBER 22, 1980 - 7:30 P.M. REGULAR MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE,  
ALD. LEWIS, ALD. COX, ALD. KING AND ALD. PACK IN  
ATTENDANCE.

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the September 8, 1980, regular meeting, Sept. 15 and Sept. 19, 1980 meetings were read and approved.
3. Mayor's Comments:
  - (a) Mayor Burdette explained the Block Grant for Community Projects which would be open for applications in November, 1980. He ask the Council to be considering a project.
  - (b) Mayor Burdette gave a brief summary of his trip to Washington, D.C. on Sept. 16 and 17 regarding legislation to continue revenue sharing which expires on Sept. 30, 1980.
  - (c) The Council set two special Meeting dates of Sept. 29 and Oct. 2, 1980, noon, to read and adopt the bond ordinances for the 1980A interim bonds.
  - (d) Mayor Burdette announced the Sept. 23 informal meeting with the county commissioners to discuss joint programs.
  - (e) Mr. Burdette announced that he had proclaimed Oct. 5 - 11 as Fire Prevention week as Mayor of the City.
  - (f) The Council approved the closing of McDaniel Station Road on October 25, 1980 from 9:15 A. M. until Noon for a Community Drive for St. Jude's Children Hospital.

6. Old Business:
  - (a) Ald. Lewis made a motion to waive the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th readings and approve the water-sewer rate ordinance as read on Sept. 8, 1980. 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Pack and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively also.
  - (b) City Superintendent Hobgood stated the paving was complete on Richardson Road, with some work being done on the Belwood Road. The work has changed the appearance and usefulness of the area a great deal. The replacement of the water line on the Resaca bridge has been completed. A 12 inch steel pipe was used. Mr. Hobgood explained that the City has an understanding with the State Dept. of Transportation that two lines can be attached to the bridge. Only one line is attached at this time.
  - (c) The Council appointed the following to serve on the graphics (sign) Ordinance Committee:  
Anthony King, Chairman; Bill Moore, Phil Overton, Rembert Moore, Rodney Harbin, Dianne Rosencrance, Sham Idnani, and Ald. Ed Lewis.
7. New Business:
  - (a) Ald. Cox made a motion to appoint Cathy Harrison as Superintendent of the City General Election to be held on November 19, 1980; Hoyt Edwards as Election Manager; Dixon Owen as Absentee Ballot Clerk and Registrar; with the two assistant managers to be appointed by the Election Manager. 2nd by Ald. Lewis, with Ald. Pack and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.



Last Day of Registration by Voters - October 29, 1980


8. Ald. Lewis made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Cox and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
