



OCTOBER 13, 1980 - 7:30 P.M. REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE,
ALD. LEWIS, ALD. KING, ALD. COX AND ALD. PACK IN ATTENDANCE

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Sept. 22, 1980, regular meeting and the Sept. 23, 1980, Sept. 29, 1980 (two) and Oct. 2, 1980 special meetings were read and approved.
3. Mayor's Comments: (a) Mayor Burdette gave a brief report on the 7th district GMA meeting held in Marietta on Oct. 7, 1980.
(b) Mayor Burdette announced two public hearings for Oct. 27, 1980, at 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. at the city courtroom regarding the city/county block grant application for sewerage of portions of the Fox Subdivision area.
4. Aldermen's Comments: None
5. Public Comments: (a) Bill Avery of GMA presented printouts of proposed retirement schedules on the City's present unfunded plan and on a proposed JMERS plan. Mr. Avery gave a review of the material and answered questions. The Council stated they needed to study the plan thoroughly before making any decisions.
6. Old Business: (a) Ald. Lewis made a motion to set the date of Oct. 27, 1980 at 7:30 p.m. for a public hearing of a zoning change request from R-2 to C-2 on the house and lot fronting the New Town Road, across from Triangle Grocey. The property being owned by Mrs. Bessie Fuller. 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. Pack and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
(b) City Superintendent Hobgood stated the Street Dept. continued to do ditch work and base work on the Belwood (Flowers) Road. The railroad has completed the Court Street and Line Street crossings. He explained that six of the original eight people requesting sewer line extension earlier on Circle Dr had again requested an extension paying the full cost of the work. The Electric Dept. has been adding lighting to the parking area on the south side of the gym at the high school.
(c) Ald. Lewis made a motion to grant a renewal of the William Page trailer permit for S. Wall Street for an additional six months period, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Pack and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively also.
7. New Business: (a) Ald. Pack made a motion to condemn the partially burned house at 122 Neal Street as per the Building Inspector's request, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Lewis and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively also.
(b) Ald. Pack made a motion to approve the paving contract and maintenance agreement for paving of King Street and Beamer Road (1.5 miles total), and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign the contract and agreements. 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. King and Ald. Lewis voting affirmatively also.
(c) Ald. Cox made a motion to adopt a resolution regarding acquisition and clearance of right-of-ways for the above mentioned project, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Lewis and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
(d) A first reading was given to the Milton Stewart, Forrest Heights Subdivision property annexation ordinance request. The property being located off Highway 53 and being bound by the Maplewood Subdivision. The request being for R1 zoning.
8. Ald. Pack made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. King and Ald. Lewis voting affirmatively also.
