

NOVEMBER 24, 1980 - 7:30 P.M. REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE,
ALD. LEWIS, ALD. COX, ALD. KING AND ALD. PACK IN ATTENDANCE

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Nov. 10, 1980, regular meeting were read and approved.
3. Mayor's Comments: (a) Mayor Burdette reported on a meeting held Nov. 18, 1980, in Atlanta with Georgia EPD officials regarding the City's request to withdraw water from the Coosawattee River. The Georgia EPD will make a study of the river vs. tap requests which could take six to nine months. No further permits will be approved until the study is complete, but Calhoun did get permission because of the progress made by the City for the intake and because of early encouragement of Georgia EPD.
(b) Mayor Burdette congratulated Ald. Cox and Ald. Pack on their re-election to the Council.
4. Aldermen's Comments: None
5. Public Comments: (a) Mr. and Mrs. Ross Holland requested a fence on the right-of-way of Barrett Road, at the east side of their house which fronts on Hunts Drive. The request being made due to the numerous wrecks occurring at the area where Barrett Road narrows, near their property. After discussion, the Council assured the Holland's the City would make every effort to improve the situation.
6. Old Business: (a) A second reading was given to the pawn shop license request of James David (Jimmy) Gee at 208 S. Wall Street. The police report was favorable. Ald. Cox made a motion to approve the request, 2nd by Ald. Lewis with Ald. Pack and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
(b) A second reading was given to the following beer/wine/liquor license holders for renewals of their licenses for 1981.

 Ald. Lewis made a motion to approve, 2nd by Ald. Cox, with Ald. King and Ald. Pack voting affirmatively also.
(c) City Supt. Hobgood reported street work on Sequoyah Terrace had been completed. Right-of-ways have continued to be cleared for the street and utility departments. The City continues to work with engineers from Fafnir regarding water pressure at the future site. A small amount of clearing is being done on the tank site donated by Raymond King. John Sweitzer continues to work on expansion of water system; taking pressure and flow tests in the county where tie-ins will be made. Some preliminary work is being done on the Beamer Road right-of-way. Supt. Hobgood stated that since the loss of the Rabies Control truck, it is necessary to replace a meter truck and give the older truck to Rabies Control. The Council asked Supt. Hobgood to obtain bids for the next meeting. Mr. Hobgood asked each Council member to read and review the City's EPA 201, step one study plan.
7. New Business: (a) Election Supt. Cathy Harrison gave the election results of the Nov. 19, 1980 election. Results as per the attached.


(e) A first reading was given to the handicapped parking law.
