

DECEMBER 22, 1980 - 7:30 P.M. REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE,  
ALD. LEWIS, ALD. KING, ALD. COX AND ALD. PACK IN ATTENDANCE

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Dec. 8, 1980, regular meeting were read and approved.
3. Mayor's Comments: (a) Mayor Burdette reported that Revenue Sharing had passed the Senate on Dec. 10 for three additional years, as an entitlement with the January payments to be received on schedule on the same level as before.  
(b) Mayor Burdette welcomed Senator Elect Max Brannon to the meeting.
4. Aldermen's Comments: (a) Ald. Pack requested that the older streets in Fain Cemetery be repaved and improved as the money is available.
5. Public Comments: (a) Don Watt made several brief comments concerning the Facility Plan as prepared in Step 1 of the EPA 201 Study.  
(b) After discussion, Ald. Cox made a motion to adopt the resolution of acceptance of the Facility Plan with options to amend in the future if necessary, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Pack and Ald. Lewis voting affirmatively also.
6. Old Business: (a) Ald. Lewis made a motion to approve a renewal of the 1981 beer license for Tony Brown's, Troy's, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Cox and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.  
(b) After a second reading, acknowledgement of proper advertisement, and a favorable police report, Ald. Lewis made a motion to approve a beer license request for Paul Land d/b/a P.K.'s Landing at the former location of Hickory Log Bar-B-Q, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Cox and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.  
(c) After a second reading, Ald. Pack made a motion to waive the 3rd and 4th readings, and approve the annexation request of Consolidated Foods Corp. for 8.9 acres located off Fred Hurley Road and being formerly known as "The Meat Company" at Ind. G zoning, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. Lewis and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.  
(d) City Supt. Hobgood reported that work was being hampered by the gas company on Beamer Road; airport pad is complete; driveway to pad is now being done; sewer line installation to Fafnir is complete; sewer line has been run to the Church of Christ on 41 South and they have connected; clearing work is being continued on proposed water tank sites; Sweitzer is behind approximately two months on plans; a larger water line has been run from the North 41 12" line to the FineCrafts building behind the former Calhoun Chemical building with three users paying the cost of the line, \$5500.00. Supt. Hobgood and Rep. Ralston met with Director Tom Moreland concerning the 136 connector.
7. New Business: (a) After discussion, Ald. Lewis made a motion to rescind the 1981 beer license for Walter Lee James as manager of VFW Post 5376 and approve a 1981 beer license for Jimmy Beasley, as manager, subject to a favorable police report, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Cox and Ald. Pack voting affirmatively.  
(b) A first reading was given to the 1981 beer license renewal request of Charley Butler's Eureka.  
(c) A general discussion followed regarding promotion of the Chandler Cemetery and the scarcity of lots left at the Fain Cemetery. Ald. Cox made a motion to open the north side of the new Chandler Addition, for monuments above


