

APRIL 26, 1982 - 7:30 P.M. REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE,
 ALD. COX AND ALD. PACK IN ATTENDANCE (Ald. Lewis and Ald.
 King attending a Chamber of Commerce Conference in Washington, D. C.)

1. Mayor W. C. Burdette called the meeting to order and Rev. Daryl L. Meyers, Hospital Chaplain, gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the April 12, 1982, regular meeting and April 22, 1982, special meeting were read and approved.

5. Public Comments: (a) A public hearing was held on the beer license request of Billy Sanders, Manager of American Legion 555. A favorable police report was given and no adverse comments were made at the public hearing. The Mayor advised Mr. Sanders that with two Council members absent, he would have to vote in order to have a quorum and that he would not be able to give a favorable vote on any beer/wine/or liquor license. He further advised Mr. Sanders he would recommend holding the voting until the May 10, 1982, meeting. Mr. Sanders, Ald. Cox and Ald. Pack concurred.

- (b) A third reading was given to the parade route ordinance.
- (c) A second reading was given to the solicitations by organizations ordinances.
- (d) A second reading was given to the Calhoun First National Bank annexation ordinance request for 3.36 acres off Highway 53, East for C-2 zoning. Ald. Cox made a motion to waive the 3rd & 4th readings and approve, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Mayor Burdette voting affirmatively also. (ordinance # 56)
- (e) City Supt. Hobgood reported that work was continuing on River Street. The new street sweeper has been received and is in operation. The city water crews have now moved to 136 North to Sugar Valley. The city crews have put in 20 miles of line on the FmHA project, for over a total of 30 miles during the last year. This represents a good return on the equipment. The Council approved a sewer line extension and tap request by the High School for rest room facilities in the home stands. The Council requested the City Supt. check out the drainage problems in Crestment and give an estimate to correct at the next meeting, also to continue working on the Spring Valley situation.
- (f) Bids were opened on a 20' trailer for the water/sewer construction departments for hauling backhoes and pipe. Case Power & Equipment, Atlanta, (per specifications) - \$7,920.00; Chattam Machinery, Inc., Forrest Park, (per specifications) - \$6,389.00; King Ford Tractor, (not according to specification) - \$5,530.00. On recommendation of the City Supt. for the need of a trailer according to specifications, Ald. Pack made a motion to accept the low bid of \$6,389.00, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Mayor Burdette voting affirmatively also.
- 7. New Business: (a) A first reading was given to the Woodridge Estates Sub-division annexation ordinance requests for R-1 zoning, and to the Hall Realty, Inc. request for approximately one acre across Highway 143, for R-2 zoning.
- 8. Ald. Pack made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Mayor Burdette voting affirmatively.
