

JUNE 28, 1982 - 7:30 P.M. REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE,  
ALD. LEWIS, ALD. COX, ALD. KING AND ALD. PACK IN ATTENDANCE

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and City School Superintendent Smallwood gave the invocation.
  2. Minutes of the June 21, 1982, Council meeting were read and approved.
  3. Mayor's Comments: (a) Mayor Burdette stated that the complaint from the property owner regarding the wall being damaged due to installation of the transmission line on the Newtown Road has been settled by the engineer, contractor and the damaged party.
  4. Aldermen's Comments: None
  5. Public Comments: (a) In response to the prior week's question concerning bids on city gasoline and fuels, City Purchasing Agent Edwards stated that the price has been the deciding factor in determining the dealer to be selected. Current prices per gallon being Owenby (Dalton) - regular gasoline \$1.128; unleaded \$1.168; diesel fuel \$1.10; Gulf (Calhoun) regular \$1.168; unleaded \$1.21; diesel fuel \$1.135; Collins Petroleum (Calhoun) regular \$1.23; unleaded \$1.27; diesel fuel \$1.225. Gulf dealer Philip Beamer stated that he would be willing to sell regular at \$1.148 per gallon; unleaded at \$1.191 per gallon. After further discussion, Ald. Lewis made a motion to accept the low bid for fuel from local dealers, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Cox and Ald. King voting affirmative also.
  6. Old Business: (a) A second reading was given to the Sammy Wyatt annexation ordinance request on approximately one acre off Highway 53 West for R-2 zoning.
    - (b) After a second reading, Ald. Lewis made a motion to waive the 3rd and 4th readings of the annexation ordinance request of Mrs. Zane Goss for a house and lot off Burton Drive for R-1 zoning and approve. 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. King and Ald. Pack voting affirmatively. (ordinance No. 69)
    - (c) Ald. Lewis made a motion to table the Harold Black request for being allowed to hold wrestling tournaments at the W. Line Street gym, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Cox and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
    - (d) City Supt. Hobgood reported that the Calhoun-Fairmount contract regarding water sales to Fairmount has been signed and the state grant application would now be forwarded to Atlanta by John Sweitzer. Supt. Hobgood stated that the raw water intake work was proceeding; the Stephens Company had finished the transmission lines and was in the process of testing for leaks.
    - (e) After discussion, Ald. Lewis made a motion to adopt by resolution the 1982-83 city budget as per the attached summary, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Cox and Ald. Pack voting affirmatively also.
  7. New Business: (a) Ald. Cox made a motion to grant a 10 ft. variance off Fain Street for the First Baptist Church to construct a building addition. 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Lewis and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
    - (b) Mayor Burdette announced that Jim Gardner had offered the three houses and lots on Fair Street near the High School for approximately \$45,000.00. After further discussion, the Council asked City Superintendent Smallwood to discuss the request with the City Board and report their decision to the Council at a later meeting.

- (c) The Mayor announced a request by the County for the City to fund 25% of the salary for a full time Civil Defense Director to be housed at the County Fire Station on S. Wall Street. The City would not be required to furnish any other operating cost. Ald. Pack made a motion to deny the request, 2nd by Ald. Lewis with Ald. Cox and Ald. King voting affirmatively also. Mayor Burdette asked that his affirmative response to the motion be recorded to show a unified opinion of the Council.
- (b) Ald. Lewis made a motion to change the MEAG voting delegate from Hoyt Edwards to Jack Bell effective immediately at the request of Mr. Edwards, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Pack and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively also.
- 8. Ald. Pack made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. King and Ald. Lewis voting affirmatively also.
