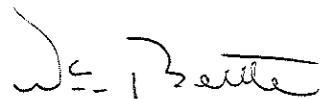


JULY 26, 1982 - 7:30 P.M. REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE,
ALD. LEWIS, ALD. COX, ALD. KING AND ALD. PACK IN ATTENDANCE

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and Phil Overton gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the July 12, 1982, regular Council meeting were read and approved.
3. Mayor's Comments: (a) Mayor Burdette reported that D.O.T. Commissioner Tom Moreland accompanied by Senator Max Brannon held a meeting with the County and City on July 23, 1982 regarding the current road conditions.
4. Aldermen's Comments: (a) Ald. Lewis stated that he had received a call from Henry Holland commending the City Fire Dept. for their prompt and professional service to a fire call at his home on July 18, 1982.
(b) Ald. Pack asked for assistance for a truck for the Recreation Dept. The City Council donated one previously used by the Wastewater Plant.
5. Public Comments: None
6. Old Business: (a) City Supt. Hobgood stated that the Water Construction Dept. was back at work on the Shope Road extension after spending a good bit of time on maintenance. He stated the remaining house on Oothcalooga and River Streets should be moved on Tuesday. The Electric Dept. is relocating the power lines and work will begin shortly in order to finish by the date school is to be reopened. A bus lane will be added from the light on Oothcalooga Street to the school driveway.
(b) A copy of the proposed resolution enacting the Downtown Development Authority was presented to each Council member to review prior to the Aug. 9, 1982, meeting. Phil Overton was asked to supply the Council with names of the downtown businesses in order to select the authority members.
(c) The City Clerk presented the year end budget/actual expense summary for 1981-1982. The income/expenses were over budget by less than $\frac{1}{2}$ of 1%.
(d) Ald. Cox made a motion to adopt a resolution on the acquisition and clearance of right-of-ways on 1.078 miles of the By-pass Road, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Pack and Ald. Lewis voting affirmatively also.
(e) Ald. Cox made a motion to approve the maintenance agreement on the above project and authorize the Mayor to sign said agreement, 2nd by Ald. Lewis with Ald. King and Ald. Pack voting affirmatively also.
7. New Business: (a) A wine application was presented from Charles Giddens for the store operated as Charlie's on Highway 41 South. A public hearing was set for Aug. 9, 1982, at 7:30 p.m.
(b) After discussion, Ald. King made a motion to grant a 20 ft. variance for the owners of the Omelet Shoppe for a new on-premise sign to be erected, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. Lewis and Ald. Pack voting affirmatively also.
8. Ald. Lewis made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. King and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively also.
