

OCT. 25, 1982 - 7:30 P.M. REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE,
ALD. LEWIS, ALD. COX, ALD. KING AND ALD. PACK IN ATTENDANCE.

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the October 11, 1982 regular City Council Meeting were read and approved.
3. Mayor's Comments: (a.) Mayor Burdette stated that Halloween would be observed on Saturday night with "trick or treat" being reserved for children in and under the fifth grade.
(b.) The Mayor reminded everyone that the last day of voter registration or candidate qualification would be Wednesday, October 27, 1982 until 5:00 P.M.
(c.) The Mayor announced a November 23, 1982 meeting with DCA officials to discuss the City/County Block Grant application.
4. Aldermen's Comments: None
5. Public Comments:
(a.) Mr. Adrian Howell of Star House in Rome, GA. made a presentation to the Council regarding Star House and its function for surrounding cities and counties. He reported on the number of residents which had used their facility in the last five years.
Ald. Lewis made a motion to contribute \$2,000.00 to Star House in support of City citizens which had used the facility (the county had agreed to contribute \$3,000.00), provided the City attorney approved the legality of the contribution. He also stated that any future contributions be reviewed by the Council prior to payment. 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Pack and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively also.
(b.) The Council reviewed the comments from Beer-Wine-Liquor retail operators concerning opening and closing hours. After discussion, the Council ask that the ordinance amendment be prepared to provide an opening hour of 6:00 A.M. and a closing hour of 11:00 P.M.
6. Old Business:
(a.) City Supt. Hobgood reported that NGEMC should have the raw-water electric line complete by mid November, 1982. Mr. Hobgood stated that test on the system should be ready by the first of the year.
(b.) Bids were opened on a garbage body: Consolidated Disposal, Marietta, GA. - \$17,272.00; Mayo Co.. Inc., Austell, GA. - \$14,993.43; Tri-State, Dalton, GA., \$15,110.00. Supt. Hobgood recommended the Leach Body by Tri-State since the city now uses that type and older ones can be used for parts, and the operators are familiar with the product. Ald. Lewis made a motion to follow the superintendent's recommendation and accept the Tri-State bid of \$15,110.00, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. Pack and Ald. King voting affirmatively also. Prater Ford stated there had been a misunderstanding two weeks earlier regarding the size of truck the City would be considering. The Council ask Supt. Hobgood to check the seating capabilities and report back. (Prater Ford bid \$42,876.00 on an L-9000)

(b.) Ald. Cox made a motion to approve erection of a 3' x 3' sign ^{for Dwight Wilson} between the curb and sidewalk at the house on N. Wall street adjoining the Billings residence. 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Lewis and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.

(c.) A First reading was given to a house moving ordinance amendment regarding regulation of houses moved on city streets, conforming with state regulations.

(d.) A First reading was given to an ordinance amending the speed limit to 35MPH on Highway 156 near the school to allow for flashers to be erected.

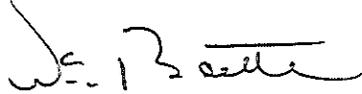
(e.) A discussion was held on adopting a lease law, but no official action was taken.

(f.) A First reading was given to an ordinance officially amending the speed limit to 20MPH on Gallman, Wilson, Crest, Talley and Powell Streets.

(g.) Ald. King made a motion to approve the agreement with CVAPD Commission on transportation for the Elderly in the nutrition program, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. Pack and Ald. Lewis voting affirmatively also.

8. Ald. Lewis made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Cox and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
