

1. Mayor Meadows reviewed a request from a Federal Agency, in which they requested the City of Calhoun build a building which would house agencies from three counties moving into Gordon County to lease space from the facility. The Council asked for additional information, and stated the matter would be continued until January 20, 1997 prior to a decision being made.
