

1. Attorney Bailey reviewed the memorandum he had forwarded to the Mayor and Council recently regarding the Interstate Sign Ordinance currently in existence in the City's Zoning Ordinances. He reviewed the options available to the Mayor and Council, and based upon discussion, Attorney Bailey was asked to review the minutes for the hearings held in 1984 to determine the strength of the City's defense in a possible law suit regarding the ordinance. Also in response to the law suit, Attorney Bailey stated that he had notified the opposing Council that prior to a law suit, the request would need to be forwarded to the City's Appeals Board which is the Mayor and Council regarding the Building Inspector's refusal to permit the signs. Attorney Bailey was authorized to set the appeals hearing for October 13, 1997 at 7:00 P. M.
