


JULY 13, 1981 - 7:30 P.M. REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE,  
ALD. LEWIS, ALD. KING, ALD. PACK AND ALD. COX IN ATTENDANCE

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the June 29, 1981, regular city council meeting were read and approved with the following amendments: No. 7(c) \$250.00 changed to \$400.00; No. 7(e) 6 acres changed to 11.25 acres; No. 7(g) 6 changed amended to charged
3. Mayor's Comments: (a) Mayor Burdette reminded the Council of the beer-liquor hearings scheduled for Tuesday, 7:00 p.m. July 14, 1981 and Wednesday, 6:00 p.m. July 15, 1981.  
(b) Mayor Burdette reminded the Council of the Coosa Valley Area Planning annual meeting Thursday, July 16, 1981.
4. Aldermen's Comments: None
5. Public Comments: (a) Donnie Bailey of Calhoun LP Gas requested the Council to consider not requiring his company to purchase a business license since it is located outside the City and only makes deliveries inside the City. City Attorney Tom E. Shanahan was asked to review the request and refer his findings to the Council.
6. Old Business: (a) 1. City Supt. Jim Hobgood stated the contaminated water took three days to pass in the river. There are still some traces in water mains and tanks. At this time, EPA has not notified the source of the contamination to the City.  
2. Supt. Hobgood stated that Sewer Plant Supervisor Jimmy Fox was to be commended for the job he did for the water plant as well as his duties, during the period Water Plant Supervisor Estes Pass was absent.  
3. The Street Dept. should be able to complete the Beamer Road project in approximately two weeks.  
(b) A second reading was given to the rezoning request of Raymond Bagwell for two lots on Crest Drive from R-2 to R-3 with a variance.  
(c) A second reading was given to the annexation application of John Slagle for 1½ acres off Richardson Road, located behind Del Taco's for R-2 zoning. Ald. Pack made a motion to waive the 3rd and 4th reading and approve for R-2 zoning on the condition the property is sold to Raymond Bagwell, 2nd by Ald. Lewis with Ald. Cox and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.  
(d) Ald. Lewis made a motion to waive the 3rd and 4th readings of the ordinance to adopt the City of Calhoun Employees Pension Plan to be governed by provisions of the joinder agreement with Mass. Mutual Life Insurance Company 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. Pack and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.  
(e) Ald. Pack made a motion to waive the 3rd and 4th reading of the ordinance to set salaries of the Mayor at \$400.00; Aldermen at \$200.00 and Court Recorder at \$150.00 effective Jan. 1, 1983, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. King and Ald. Lewis voting affirmatively also.  
(f) Ald. Cox made a motion to waive the 2nd and 3rd reading of the annexation ordinance request from the Industrial Development Authority for approximately 11.25 acres off Highway 41, former site of C.M. Jones plant/<sup>and approve</sup> Industrial H zoning, 2nd by Ald. Lewis with Ald. King and Ald. Pack voting affirmatively also.
7. New Business: (a) Ald. Cox made a motion to reappoint Thomas L. Shanahan to the Board for the Housing Authority for the term July 16, 1981 through July 16, 1986, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Pack and Ald. Lewis voting affirmatively also.

- (b) A request for a license for beer to be consumed on the premise was presented for Alice Bowen, manager for Holiday Inn Restaurant. A public hearing was set for July 27, 1981.
  - (c) Ald. Pack made a motion authorizing the Mayor to sign utility contracts with new or expanding industry for minimum bills regarding anticipated load projections, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. Lewis and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
  - (d) Ald. Lewis made a motion that the City would not extend sewer lines into the County except in instances governed by unfulfilled agreements as of this date. 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Cox and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
  - (e) Ald. King made a motion to grant two variances for placement of small Presbyterian Church signs to be placed on Northeast corner of N. Wall and Red Bud Roads and Southeast corner of Trammell & N. Wall St., 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Cox and Ald. Lewis voting affirmatively also.
8. Ald. Pack made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Lewis with Ald. Cox and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
