

July 27, 1981 - 7:30 P.M. Regular City Council Meeting with Mayor Burdette,
Ald. Lewis, Ald. Cox, Ald. King and Ald. Pack in attendance


1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the July 13, 1981 regular Council Meeting were read and approved.
3. Mayor's Comments:
 - a. Mayor Burdette ask the Council to express an opinion on the form of county government to be voted on on Aug. 4, 1981. After discussion, Ald. Lewis made a motion to endorse the multi-person form of government rather than the single individual form, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Cox voting affirmatively, and Ald. Pack abstaining.
4. Aldermen's Comments: None
5. Public Comments:
 - a. Ald. King made a motion to condemn the wood frame house on the corner of the Red Bud Road and High Point Drive and being owned by Bruce Stansell, on the recommendation of Building Inspector Bruce Bowman as per inspection of July 21, 1981, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. Pack and Ald. Lewis voting affirmatively also. Since the owner has agreed to move the building no notice of condemnation will be necessary.
6. Old Business:
 - a. Ald. Lewis made a motion to waive the fourth reading and approve the rezoning request for two lots on Crest Drive, with a variance to allow for location of trailers. Zoning change from R-2 to R-3. 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Pack and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively.
 - b. A Public Hearing was held on the Beer to be consumed on the premises License request of Alice Faye Bowen/Manager Holiday Inn Restaurant. A clear police report was given. Ald. Lewis made a motion to approve, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Pack and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively also. Mayor Burdette ask that the record reflect that he was opposed to the issuance of the license.
 - c. City Superintendent Jim Hobgood reported the following:
 1. Prime coat for Curtis Parkway to be done July 29, 1981.
 2. Doing grassing on Beamer Road.
 3. By-Pass road progressing according to state's schedule.
 4. City Supt. attended rural water Seminar in Rome on July 23, 1981 to discuss common problems among cities and water systems.
 5. Bid opening on materials for large water line from intake to water plant on July 28, 1981 at 2:00 P.M.
 - d. City Purchasing Agent Hoyt Edwards gave the Council an answer to the letter addressed to him on July 15, 1981. Mr. Edwards explained his position on all the points as mentioned in the letter.
7. New Business:
 - a. Ald. Cox made a motion to authorize the Mayor to sign agreements with Southern and L & N Railroads to obtain permission for crossing of water lines at a fee of \$50.00 or less, 2nd by Ald. Lewis with Ald. Pack and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
 - b. Ald. Lewis made a motion to accept the name change as submitted from Speedy's Spirits to Speedy's Spirits, Inc., 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. King and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively also.

c. Ald. Lewis made a motion to turn light on at the College Street old Red Bud Road intersection until the hearing on Aug. 24, 1981. 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Cox voting affirmatively, and Ald. Pack voting negataively. The motion carried.

8. Ald. Lewis made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Cox and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.
