

MARCH 12, 1979 - 7:30 P.M. REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE, ALD. LEWIS,
ALD. KING AND ALD. PACK PRESENT.

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Feb. 26, 1979, Council meeting were read and approved.
3. Mayor's Comments: Mayor Burdette read a letter from the City of Buford, GA expressing gratitude to Calhoun's Electric Dept. for their assistance during the recent ice storm.
4. Aldermen's Comments: None
5. Public Comments: (a) Mr. and Mrs. Bobby Bryant requested two 30 minute parking spaces on Piedmont Street in front of Barker's Flower Shop. The City Supt. was asked to designate the area with appropriate signs for a trial period.
6. Old Business: (a) City Supt. Hobgood stated that the Peter Street Bridge was closed Monday. The new bridge construction would take approximately 3 months to complete. He reported that approximately 1200 feet of the Challenge-Cook sewer line had been installed. The water line would be delayed until Richardson Road was improved.
Supt. Hobgood reported that the recent rain storm had damaged several areas with the Recreation Dept. being the most heavily damaged of City owned property.
(b) After group discussion and an inspection report by Supt. Hobgood, Ald. King made a motion to condemn the apartments on Louise Avenue, with a 6 months period being given for corrective work to be done. No utilities would be furnished for the apartments as they were vacated until the improvements were made and inspected. 2nd by Ald. Lewis and approved.
(c) Ald. Lewis made a motion to waive the first reading on the \$410,000.00 general obligation bond referendum ordinance, 2nd by Ald. Pack and approved.
A second reading was given to the ordinance by Clerk Harrison and Attorney Shanahan. Ald. Pack made a motion to waive the 3rd & 4th readings and approve the bond referendum ordinance as stated on the 2nd reading, 2nd by Ald. Lewis and approved.
Ald. Lewis made a motion to appoint Hoyt Edwards as Election Superintendent and Cathy Harrison as Election Manager for the above mentioned bond referendum for April 18, 1979. 2nd by Ald. Pack and approved.
(d) A second reading was given to the no parking ordinance for State Route 53 near I-75. Ald. Lewis made a motion to waive the 3rd & 4th reading and approve as read, 2nd by Ald. Pack and approved.
7. New Business: (a) Clerk Harrison gave a 1st reading to the annexation ordinance request made by Mr. and Mrs. Therrell Goswick for lot 91 in Devonwood Subdivision on Derby Lane.
(b) After discussion and a report by the Building Inspector, Ald. King made a motion to condemn the S. B. Printup house on McConnell and Court, with a ninety day notification, 2nd by Ald. Lewis and approved.
(c) A request was presented by vocation teachers Ellis Hite and Charlie Chadwick of Calhoun High School to allow construction of a home on a lot in the Don Sanders Subdivision on Dews Pond Road. After discussion, Ald. Pack made a motion to authorize the Mayor to sign a \$4,500.00, 90 day note, on the lot, provided a clear title was obtained. 2nd by Ald. King and approved.
(d) Mayor Burdette asked Supt. Hobgood to caution all city drivers to use caution and keep speed low going into the sanitary landfill.
(e) Mayor Burdette asked Supt. Hobgood to check Garden Hills Drive.
(f) Mayor Burdette asked Clerk Harrison to publish a quarterly reminder regarding dog registration.

(g) Ald. Lewis asked Clerk Harrison to contact Representative Ralston and Senator Langford regarding a meeting with the Council after the current legislature is complete.

8. Ald. Lewis made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Pack and approved.
