

JULY 23, 1979 - 7:30 P.M. REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE,
ALD. LEWIS, ALD. COX, ALD. KING AND ALD. PACK IN ATTENDANCE

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the July 9, 1979, regular meeting and July 16, 1979, special meeting were read and approved.
3. Mayor's Comments: (a) Mayor Burdette reminded the Council of a work meeting scheduled for July 31, 1979, with the County at the city courtroom at 7:30 p.m. (b) Mayor Burdette commended the County Sheriff's Dept. for its joint efforts with the City Police Dept. in arresting the current window destruction suspects.
4. Aldermen's Comments: (a) Ald. Cox asked that the City Supt. & Clerk review the airport contract and determine who needs to do maintenance to the hanger beams in order to prevent rust drops on enclosed planes.
5. Public Comments: None
6. Old Business: (a) Clerk Harrison gave a second reading to the annexation ordinance request of Eddie Joe and Joan C. Gallman, a lot on White Street bound on the east by Lovinggood property for R-2 zoning. Ald. Pack made a motion to waive the 3rd and 4th reading and approve the request, 2nd by Ald. Lewis with Ald. King and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively also. (b) Clerk Harrison gave a second reading to the annexation request of Dick Tribble for a lot on White Street bound on the east by Lovinggood property for R-2 zoning. Ald. Lewis made a motion to waive the 3rd and 4th reading and approve, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. Pack and Ald. King voting affirmatively also. (c) Clerk Harrison gave a second reading to the annexation requests of Wallace Bryant for parcels 10, 11, 18A, 19 and 43 of map 45-1 of the Gordon County Tax Assessor's records; parcel no. 29 of map no 44-4 of the Gordon County Tax Assessor's records. All tracts requesting C-2 zoning and being located within the South Wall Street Shopping Center complex. Ald. Cox made a motion to waive the 3rd and 4th reading and approve the request, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Pack and Ald. Lewis voting affirmatively also. (d) City Supt. Hobgood reported that he had visited Tom Moreland, of the Dept. of Transportation regarding additional street paving contracts. Due to budget demands, Mr. Moreland deferred the request until later. He also discussed the water line relocation job, and the Richardson Road draining and grading contract. Supt. Hobgood stated that ditch piping had been done near the school property for short distances. Auditorium work progressing; electrical cut-ins being made for Challenge-Cook; and the S. Wall shopping center.
7. New Business: (a) Bids were opened for three water, street and electric pickups as well as one for the meter reading department they were:

Prater Ford - water-electric-street - 3 trucks	\$6,063.68 each;
1 meter reading truck	5,445.12
Roy Davis - water-electric-street - 3 trucks	\$5,850.00 each;
1 meter reading truck	5,275.00

 Ald. Lewis made a motion to accept the low bid on all from Roy Davis Chevrolet, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Cox and Ald. King voting affirmatively also. (b) Ald. Pack made a motion for the City to pay one-half of the overrun on a paving contract with the Dept. of Transportation for the streets in the Recreation area, should there be a overrun. The County would also pay one-half, 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. Lewis and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.

(c) Clerk Harrison presented a zoning request for a lot owned by Wallace Bryant fronting on South Wall Street joining the former Stamey property and being formerly owned by Grace Alexander. The request being to change R-1 zoning to C-2 zoning. Proper legal advertising had been done in the legal organ, as well as written recommendation to make the change from the Zoning Committee. Ald. King made a motion to approve the request, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Lewis and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively also.

(d) Ald. Lewis made a motion to accept the Danny Greeson beer package store license application for the store formerly known as J J's Package; and set the public hearing on Aug. 13, 1979. 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. Pack and Ald. King voting affirmatively also.

(e) Ald. Cox made a motion to appoint Wilson Baxley and Calvin Caldwell to a 5 year term each on the Housing Authority Commission, expiring July 16, 1984. 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Lewis and Ald. King voting affirmatively.

(f) Bids were opened for the outside painting of the Police Station, Cecil Mashburn \$995.00; Billy Black \$1350.00; Ald. Cox made a motion to accept the low bid of \$995.00 from Cecil Mashburn, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Lewis and Ald. Pack voting affirmatively.

(g) Ald. Lewis made a motion to pass a resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign the amended agreement with the Dept. of Transportation regarding the purchase of pipe to relocate the water line from West Calhoun to Plainville, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Cox and Ald. Pack voting affirmatively also.

(h) A discussion was held on the budget to actual expenses and revenue for the year 1978-79.

8. Ald. King made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. Lewis and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively also.
