

DECEMBER 17, 1979 - 7:30 P.M. REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING WITH MAYOR BURDETTE,
ALD. LEWIS, ALD. COX, ALD. KING AND ALD. PACK IN ATTENDANCE

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Dec. 10, 1979, regular meeting were read and approved, with one change being authorized in the Mayor's comments, item 3 the dates of Dec. 12 Rome visit and Dec. 13, Milledgeville visit were to be reversed.
3. Mayor's Comments: (a) Mayor Burdette stated that he and City Administrator Hoyt Edwards participated in the Mayor's Motorcade to Milledgeville on the 12th. The participation by Georgia cities was off and the amount of gifts had dropped considerably. Ald. King and Mayor Burdette attended the Regional Hospital on the 13th.
4. Aldermen's Comments: Ald. Lewis made a motion to adopt a resolution indicative of Mr. J. Roy McGinty's service to the City of Calhoun during his tenure. This resolution to be presented to Mrs. McGinty. 2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. King and Ald. Pack voting affirmatively also. The City Hall will fly the city flag at half mask on the 18th in reverence to Mr. McGinty.
5. Public Comments: (a) Sham Idnani, owner of the Ace Motel, requested the Council review the license fee and method of charge for motels within the City. After a general discussion, the Council asked the City Clerk to obtain pertinent information and report at the following council meeting.
6. Old Business: (a) Ald. Cox made a motion to waive the 3rd and 4th readings of the amendment to the business and occupation tax ordinance regarding pool rooms, amusement centers, and/or pawn shops (as per attached), 2nd by Ald. Lewis with Ald. King and Ald. Pack voting affirmatively also.
(b) Ald. Lewis made a motion to waive the 3rd and 4th reading of the amendment to the zoning ordinance, 2nd by Ald. King with Ald. Cox and Ald. Pack voting affirmatively also.

2. The granter being required to pay any transfer tax should they be deemed necessary.
3. Payment of outstanding invoices due the City by W. C. Bryant.
4. Repairs to Mason Street to be approved by the City Superintendent.

2nd by Ald. Cox with Ald. King and Ald. Lewis voting affirmatively also.

8. Ald. Lewis made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Pack with Ald. King and Ald. Cox voting affirmatively also.
