

NOVEMBER 25, 1963

REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT EXCEPT  
ALD. JERRY KING.

1. Dr. Jack Lance opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Council ordered the clerk to draw a resolution eulogizing the late John F. Kennedy, thirty-fifth president of the U. S. A., and the original sent to his widow. Also to send resolution to the new president, Lyndon B. Johnson.
3. Minutes of regular meeting of Nov. 11 read and approved.
4. Supt. Owens reported that Raymond Bagwell, owner of the property on the north end of Crest Drive, would not cooperate by permitting more than ten feet for street paving and council told Mr. Owens to pave to his property at the top of the hill.
5. Ald. Lewis said he would like to see the proposed McConnell Rd. sidewalk ready for paving next spring.
6. Mayor Dickinson, with approval of the board of aldermen, appointed Dr. T. J. "Jack" Lance as chaplain of the council and an honorary aldermen of the city and ordered a resolution confirming this action mailed to Dr. Lance.
7. Ald. David moved that city employees be given the same Christmas Bonus as last year, seconded by Ald. Woods and passed.
8. Ald. David suggested that the city hall close for Christmas Day and the following day. Council agreed and Mayor Dickinson ordered this done.
9. Ald. Lewis made a motion to install parking meters on the east side of Piedmont St. from O'Callaghan St. to the property of Mrs. C. S. Jackson. Ald. David seconded the motion which was approved.
10. Ald. David moved adjournment of this meeting, 2nd by Ald. Woods and done.
