REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL, PRESENT WERE MAYOR FRANK M. DICKINSON, ALDERMEN TOM B. DAVID, JOHN A LEWIS, JR., ARDEN J. KING, ALDERMAN J. T. WOODS, JR. ABSENT, ATTENDING GRADUATION EXERCISES AT SMYRNA, GA. SUPT. OWENS AND CITY CLK. EDWARDS ABSENT ATTENDING POWER MEETING IN ALBANY, GA.

1. Mr. Jack Lance opened meeting by reading 13th verse of Cor.1st, followed by prayer.

2. Mayor Dickinson requested that Ald. Lewis secure someone to open next meeting. Also at that meeting (June 10th) the date of the following council meeting to be discussed and set.

3. Mr. Howard Robinson was heard in regard to traffic problem at his place of business. He states that when traffic is stopped at Piedmont red light, cars 3 or 4 back will cut thru his station, and often when light is red, traffic will continue to the right without stopping or slowing down. After discussion, Ald. King made motion that cross walk lines be painted on sidewalk, and "No Turn on Red" signs be placed at intersection of Piedmont and S. Wall St., and at intersection of Red Bud Road and College St. seconded by Ald. Lewis, voted on and passed.

4. Ald. Lewis states that he believes a better garbage collection schedule should be worked out.

5. Ald. Lewis reports that Boston Road is in a very bad condition, and believes that it should be resurfaced. Ald. David said that parts of Fain St. and Willard St. were in need of repair.

6. Ald. King states that Policewomen Ingle and Davis would like to work parking meters together balance of week that school is out so as to acquaint themselves with job. O'kd by Council.

7. Ald. King heard in regard to closing hours of Bowling Alley and Lunch Room., also opening hour of Martin Theater on Sunday Nite. After discussion, council agrees that Bowling Alley and Lunch Room be allowed to remain open until 4 o'clock Sunday A.M. if other towns allow same privilege. Picture show to open at 9 o'clock P.M. as has been allowed in past.

8. Ald. King mentioned that something should be done in regard to embankment at road above shopping center. Mr. Owens to take this up with Ald. Lewis.

9. Ald. David heard in regard to request by Mr. Boyd of Housing Authority that City accept Edmond Circle for street maintenance. Request tabled until extent of street limits confirmed.

10. Ald. David advises that Mr. Sherman wants to lend City money-amount up to \$20,000.00

11. VFW Recreation Park Discussed. Ald. King made motion that ~~the~~ <sup>VFW</sup> Ball Park be granted same rate as last year. Voted on and passed.

12. Ald. David made motion to adjours. Seconded and passed.
