

JUNE 10, 1963

REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

1. Mayor Dickinson opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of meeting of May 27 read and approved.
3. Former Mayor Harry T. Lawrence asked council for letter of intent to furnish sewage main for 16 unit apartment house planned for Garden Hills Subdivision. Council instructed Supt. Owens to secure pertinent information and report at special meeting to be called for decision on this project.
4. Ald. David heard in regard to City furnishing water to Regina Forest Subdivision off Oostanaula Road (outside city limits) and council's position unchanged- 36 tap fees of \$100.00 each must be on deposit in clerk's office before water main will be extended to this location.
5. Ald. Lewis in matter of Jesse Harkins' business license and council instructed clerk to collect peddlers' license from all door to door salespersons in the future.
6. Council insists on Recreation Commission paying all utility bills monthly and will increase Commission's share of budget in amount of utilities paid city if necessary to comply.
7. Ald. Lewis asked Supt. Owens to see that flag pole for Elementary School is installed by Sept. 1.
8. Ald. King moved that city purchase the 37 used parking meters (Park-o-Meters) that were originally bought by Gordon County. Total purchase price to be \$1142.97. Motion seconded by Ald. Woods and passed.
9. Council studied third quarter budget report and requested to see final report soon.
10. Supt. Owens told council of Georgia Power Co. proposal to construct new sub-station provided the city will furnish a lot 150 feet square. Ald. King made motion that the Power Co. be advised that the city was ready to proceed; 2nd by Ald. Lewis and passed.
11. Supt. Owens said he wished to pave a portion of Dale Ave. to the apartment house now under construction and Ald. King made motion that city pay one third of cost as usual.
12. Supt. Owens reported an unsightly mess at Beamer's Gin and was told to handle the situation with Mr. James Beamer.
13. Supt. Owens advised council that he needed more men or a reduction in the work load, especially in the street department.
14. June 24 council meeting cancelled due to Georgia Municipal Association Convention being held in Savannah June 23, 24, 25.
15. Ald. Lewis said he had heard several complaints from residents on the garbage schedule, or lack of one. Supt. Owens said garbage was picked up at regular intervals as much as possible with inclement weather and truck breakdowns the main sources of schedule disruption.
16. There being no further business, council was adjourned until July 8 meeting, unless sooner convened in called convocation.
