

JULY 8, 1963 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR FRANK M. DICKINSON PRESIDING; ALDERMEN DAVID, KING AND WOODS PRESENT; ALD. LEWIS ABSENT-

1. Dr. T. J. Lance opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of June 10 meeting read and approved.
3. Mr. Jack Holland, President of the Gordon County Chamber of Commerce, told council of the Chamber's need for a separate office. County Commissioner John Slagle offered the Red Cross an office in the Health Center with the approval of the Health Dept. and all agreed to await developments.
4. Ald. David advised that Mr. Dan Patty's farm was available for an airport at a price of \$40,000.00 for the 196 Acre place. Mr. David said this farm would accommodate a 6,000 ft. runway. After discussion, Mayor Dickinson and Comm. Slagle appointed Ald. David, Ald. Lewis, Dr. W. B. Gray and Marvin L. Taylor as an airport committee.
5. Furnishing the Hunt Subdivision with city sewage was discussed again and Ald. David and Supt. Owens were asked to meet with Mr. J. H. Starr to work out an arrangement with Echota Cotton Mills on this.
6. Comm. John Slagle asked City to prepare water petitions for Red Bud Road so that he might distribute them. Supt. & Clerk to attend to this.
7. Ald. King heard in the matter of parking permits and granting free parking privileges. After discussion, Council ordered strict enforcement of all parking violations.
8. Ald. David in regard to swimming pool for Negroes. Council instructed Supt. Owens to secure plans and estimate of cost of this project.
9. Council ordered stop sign at intersection of Fair & W. Court Sts. replaced.
10. Problem of Rotary Club sponsored Horse Show using ball park again postponed to meeting when all will be present.
11. Ald. Woods announced the resignation of Fireman Ferrell Grizzle and suggested Supt. Owens and Fire Chief Bill Champion hire his successor.
12. Supt. Owens told council that churches, were being charged half-price for power. Ald. King made motion that all churches be billed for power at the rate of 1¢ per KW, 2nd by Ald. David and passed.

13. Supt. Owens told council that the City had no paving distributor and that he had contracted with Northwest Georgia Paving Co. to resurface the following streets; Willard, Alexander, Valley Cir., Boston Rd., and portions of Hillcrest Drive, Fain St., & ~~Case~~ Dale Ave. Cost of paving was \$4159.76.

14. Application of Clarence E. Harris for Malt Beverage License at 712-4 N. Wall St. read, referred to license committee, and to be voted on at July 22 meeting.

15. Ald. David made motion to give Policewomen Davis and Ingle \$30.00 each in lieu of vacation pay. Ald, King seconded the motion which was unanimously adopted.

16. Ald. King moved to adjourn the meeting, Ald. David seconded the motion and the meeting was declared adjourned by Mayor Dickinson.
