

DEC. 9, 1963 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR FRANK DICKINSON, ALDERMEN TOM DAVID, JOHN A. LEWIS, JR. AND J. T. WOODS, JR. PRESENT; ALD. JERRY KING ABSENT.

1. Chaplain Jack F. Lance opened the meeting with prayer and was presented (by Mayor Dickinson) with a resolution naming him the official chaplain and also an honorary alderman of the city.
2. Minutes of regular meeting of Nov. 25 read and approved.
3. Ald. David made a motion to have the ceiling of the Chamber of Commerce office in the Civic Center lowered, seconded by Ald. Lewis and passed.
4. Ald. Lewis asked Supt. Owens to do whatever was necessary to expedite State Highway Dept. action on the traffic light proposed for S. Wall & Peters Sts.
5. Supt. Owens advised council of dispute between Wayne Hall and the Wayne Bracketts over a house that does not meet the minimum standards of the city building code.
6. Ald. Woods said that some shrubbery was still in Fain Cemetery in spite of the city's request to lot owners to remove it.
7. Ald. David moved to adjourn, Ald. Woods seconded the motion which was passed.
