


OCTOBER 28-REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Mayor Dickinson opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of October 14 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Lewis made a motion to install parking meters on the west side of Piedmont St. from Hicks St. north to Johnston-Hall Clinic. This motion seconded by Ald. David and approved.
4. Ald. Lewis moved to have Metter Lane designated a 2-way street again and Ald. David again seconded the motion which was passed.
5. Ald. Lewis recommended that a street light be installed near the J. H. Robbins' residence on Boulevard Heights as soon as one is available.
6. Ald. David made motion to change the fence on east side of the Civic Center to permit parking space for approximately six autos. This motion received the second of Ald. King and was passed.
7. Ald. David said the Recreation Commission would like to have the tennis courts re-arranged so that the sun would not be in the players' eyes and would also add ~~and~~ other games if the city would pave some additional area. Ald. David made a motion that this be done and Ald. King seconded provided the cost did not exceed \$300.00. Ald. David agreed to this amendment and the motion was voted on and passed.
8. Ald. King asked Supt. Owens to investigate the feasibility of cutting back the curb on the southeast corner of N. Wall at Line St.
9. The council adopted the budget for fiscal '64 in the amount of \$927,000.00 on motion of Ald. Lewis and second of Ald. King.
10. Ald. Lewis moved that King St. be paved as per request of several residents who signed a petition to have this done. Mr. Lewis stated in the motion that the paving was to be done only after the usual procedure was followed in regard to paying for the paving. Ald. David seconded the motion and it was voted on and passed.
11. Ald. King made a motion to have the city's auditor, R. M. Dobbs, C.P.A., prepare and publish in the Calhoun Times a financial statement for the fiscal year ending July 31, 1963. Ald. David seconded the motion which was passed.
12. Supt. Owens gave a brief report on progress being made on the erection of the 300,000 gallon standpipe and the new water main.
13. Ald. Woods moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. King and done.
