

AUGUST 30, 1963 - CALLED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR FRANK DICKINSON, ALDERMEN JERRY KING AND JOHN LEWIS, JR. PRESENT. POLICE CHIEF LUTHER ROBERTS ALSO PRESENT.

The meeting was convened at 5 P.M. and Mr. Mack Graham and Mr. Fred Fuller were present to show cause as to why their permit to do business as Calhoun Cab Co. should not be revoked since Mr. Fuller had pleaded guilty to and been fined for driving under the influence of alcoholic beverages.

Mr. Fuller insisted that although he was driving a taxi at the time of his arrest, he was not on duty and would not have accepted a fare. Mr. Fuller further stated that he had quit drinking and would turn in his license if ever caught DUI again.

Mr. Fuller was told that his license would definitely be revoked if he was convicted of driving under the influence again and this was ordered placed upon the record.

This being the sole item of business, the meeting was adjourned.
