

MARCH 11, 1963 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR FRANK M. DICKINSON, ALDERMEN TOM B. DAVID AND JOHN A. LEWIS, JR. PRESENT.

1. Mayor Dickinson opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of regular meeting of Feb. 25 read and approved.
3. Minutes of special meeting of Mar. 5 read and approved.
4. A letter from Quarterback, Lions and Kiwanis Clubs and the High School Athletic Dept. requesting assistance in re-building west stands at Phil Reeve Stadium was read and Ald. David made motion that the City participate in this project, 2nd by Ald. Lewis and passed.
5. The mayor opened and read the following bids on a '63 truck (cab & chassis only) for the street dept.:

Roy Davis Chevrolet,	
Olds, inc. -	2,554.00

Ald. Lewis moved that the Chevrolet be purchased from Roy Davis, and Mr. David seconded the motion which was voted on and passed.

Mayor Dickinson then read bids on a '63 car for Police Dept.

Roy Davis Chevy, Olds -	\$ 1449.00
Owens-Prater Ford -	1452.91
Wade Motor Co. -	1200.00

All above bids included taking city's '61 Chevrolet Biscayne as trade in. Mr. David made motion to buy the Rambler Ambassador (800) from Wade, 2nd by Mr. Lewis and passed.

6. Mr. Lewis told of surface water problem on Boston Road affecting Mrs. Bessie Grizzle and James Thomason's residences.
7. Supt. Owens said he had talked with Mr. T. F. Chitwood and that Thurman was anxious to begin construction on a new carpet mill in Resaca. City to cooperate fully.
8. Ald. David suggested that Council pass resolution in support of effort to obtain a Junior College for Calhoun and Gordon Co.
9. Council extended condolences to Mayor Dickinson in the recent death of his Mother.
10. Motion to adjourn by Ald. David, 2nd by Ald. Lewis and done.
