CALLED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

1. Purpose of meeting; to discuss the proposed new airport. After hearing from Mr. John Bennett of the Board of Industry and Trade's Aviation Division, Ald. King made a motion to consider the airport further provided that: a. Mr. Dan Patty, owner of the property under consideration, would grant a sixty (60) day extension of the option; b. the Federal Aviation Agency would approve the site; c. a qualified engineering firm would conduct a preliminary survey and give cost estimate; d. the Gordon County Commissioner of Roads and Revenue would assure the Council that the grading and earth moving would be done without delay and; e. all this be done without obligation or cost to the City of Calhoun. Ald. Woods seconded the motion and Council passed it unanimously.

2. There being no further business, the meeting was declared adjourned by Mayor Dickinson.
