


OCTOBER 25, 1965 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL, ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of Oct. 11 meeting read and approved.
3. Council adopted the \$100,000 Water Revenue Bond Ordinance which is attached hereto and the engineering survey of City Engineer James S. Owens which is incorporated in the minutes of the September 27 meeting as Item 8. Motion made by Ald. King, 2nd by Ald. Woods, voted and passed.
4. Delegation from Riverview Baptist Church complained that surface water was running from the street onto their lot. Ald. Norton moved that City install concrete pipe in two driveways to correct this. Ald. King seconded the motion. Voted and passed.
5. Ald. Woods heard in regard to parking on Oothcaloga St. between Wall and Park Ave.
6. Ald. King made a motion to grant American Legion Post 555 a Malt Beverage License upon compliance by the post with the City's ordinance. Ald. Woods seconded and the motion was unanimously passed.
7. Ald. King reported that Policewoman Mary Emma Davis had resigned effective Nov. 15 and the Police Dept. was accepting applications for a replacement.
8. Ald. Norton said the City should place a barrier on Victory Drive at the Shopping Center or insist that the owners of the Shopping Center do this. Clerk to write and remind the owners of their promise to erect a guard rail here.
9. Ald. Norton heard in regard to erecting a stop sign at Court and Piedmont. No action taken.
10. Supt. Owens said he believed house movers should be restricted in the size buildings that may be moved on city streets and the limit should be 18 ft. in height and 25 ft. in width. Ald. King moved, Ald. David 2nd, to amend the existing ordinance to include this recommendation. Motion voted and passed. City Clerk to notify local house movers.
11. Clerk read letter from Johnny Carter questioning the City's right to issue parking tickets on federal aid streets.
12. Mr. Tom Shanahan, Captain of the Calhoun Quarterback Club, expressed his appreciation to the Council for their help in improving the lighting at the HS football field.
13. Council approved for payment the bill from the Coosa Valley Area Planning and Development Comm.
14. Letter read discussing the discontinuance of L & N/^{passenger}trains nos. 94 and 95.
15. Motion to adjourn by Ald. King, seconded by Ald. Norton and done.
