

MAY 3, 1965 - CALLED MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. The following sewer service charge and water rates, agreed upon by the committee, were unanimously adopted on motion of Ald. Norton, seconded by Ald. David:

SEWER SERVICE CHARGE

0-50,000 gals.	50% of water bill
50,000-1 million gals.	33 1/3% " "
1 million-5 million gals.	25% " "
Over 5 million gals.	10% " "

Water Rates- minimums only increased. Inside city rates increased from \$1.50 per month to \$2.00, outside from \$2.25 to \$3.00 per month.

2. At the request of the Housing & Home Finance Agency, Ald. Woods moved the passage of a resolution authorizing the mayor to execute an "Assurance of Compliance" with HHFA regulations under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. Ald. Norton seconded the motion which was passed unanimously.

3. Ald. Norton moved to adjourn, Ald. David seconded and the meeting was adjourned by unanimous consent.
