

SEPT. 27, 1965 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of the meeting of Sept. 13 read and approved.
3. Mr. Lex Jolley of Jolley & Co., Atlanta told council that the \$100,000 water revenue bonds would cost 4% interest and he had scheduled \$5,000 to mature each year beginning June of 66. Ald. Woods made a motion to issue these bonds with Mr. Jolley handling the issue, Ald. David seconded, voted and passed.
4. Mr. J. C. Boyd, Executive Director of the Calhoun Housing Authority, complained that the storm sewer in the housing project was inadequate. The problem was discussed but no action taken.
5. Ald. David moved that the city furnish water, lights and sewer free of any charge to the Calhoun Woman's Club. Ald. Norton seconded the motion. Ald. King offered an amendment that the city is under no obligation to pay any other bills for the Woman's Club due to the deteriorated condition of the building. This amendment accepted and the amended motion was passed.
6. Ald. Woods moved that Beamer Gin be allowed a three month gin rate for Oct., Nov., Dec.; Ald. David seconded. Voted and passed.
7. Supt. Owens said Mr. Mitzelfelt, Gordon Co. sanitarian, had asked for the council's cooperation in dealing with Mrs. L. A. Roach over unsanitary conditions of one of her tenant houses. Council agreed to back the health dept.
8. Supt. Owens said the weeds and grass had been cut at the airport site.
9. Ald. King moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. David and done.
