

AUGUST 9, 1965 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT  
EXCEPT ALD. W. R. NORTON.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with the reading of the 143rd Psalm.
2. Minutes of the July 26 meeting were read and approved.
3. Mr. J. C. Boyd, Exec. Dir. of the Housing Authority asked council to renew the workable program with the HHFA. Mr. Boyd believes he can get some additional housing units for elderly people if the program is renewed. Ald. David moved that the program be renewed; Ald. King seconded the motion which was voted on and passed.
4. Ald. David received permission of council to pay expenses for two persons to attend a CD training course in Augusta Sept. 9 and 10. Council also approved expenses for Fireman Ferrell Grizzle and ~~two~~ others to radiological monitoring course in Rome, Aug. 17 thru 20.
5. Supt. Owens reported that the paving in the Hunt subdivision was 80% complete and the water main had been changed on the Rome Rd. at SR 53 bypass. Mr. Owens said work had begun on the lights for the football field.
6. Council asked status of parking lot petition so that story could be published. Clerk said he had received no word from L & N RR Co.
7. Ald. King moved to adjourn, Ald. David seconded and the meeting was adjourned.
