

MAY 24, 1965 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT
EXCEPT ALD. W. R. NORTON.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with scripture reading and prayer.
2. Minutes of May 10 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. King announced that a film on evacuation of buildings during a fire would be shown in the fire hall at 7:30 PM, Wednesday, May 26. Mr. King said all school principals had been invited and he asked all present to attend.
4. Ald. King said he thought the city council should issue a proclamation extolling the virtues of the high school seniors since this class has been an outstanding one. Ald. David seconded the motion, which was voted on and passed.
5. Ald. Woods expressed the opinion that the city should set a policy for the use of fire plugs by other than city firemen.
6. Ald. Woods heard in regard to the parking lot at Ojay Mills. Mr. Woods asked Supt. Owens to assist in marking the lot in order to eliminate truck parking on Oothcaloga St. in front of the plant.
7. Council agreed to sweep parking lots at supermarkets in the city at no cost to the owners. Council agreed to sweep the parking lot at Dixie Belle Mills and instructed Supt. Owens to arrive at a fair price.
8. Supt. Owens said there were several more sub-standard houses whose owners should be notified to repair or tear down. He said he would take photographs of these before notifying the owners.
9. Council told Supt. Owens to accept bids on the old Martha King house and to sell to the highest bidder.
10. Letter from Congressman John W. Davis read informing council that the city does not qualify for a new federal office bldg.
11. Council discussed possibility of opening and closing graves in Fain and Chandler cemeteries. Ald. Woods and Supt. Owens to investigate.
12. At the request of the city clerk, Ald. King made a motion, seconded by Ald. David, to impose a 10% penalty for late payment of city taxes. This ordinance to be effective after December 20, 1965. Motion passed unanimously.
13. Ald. King reported on the tax revaluation meeting attended by himself and the city supt. and city clerk.
14. Ald. David moved to adjourn, Ald. King seconded the motion; voted on and passed.
