

AUGUST 23, 1965- REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance read from the 4th Chapter of Proverbs and opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of the August 9 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Woods inquired about the right of way on Hunt Drive and stated that Mr. F. G. Abbott had registered a complaint. Supt. Owens said the street could not be widened any more.
4. Ald. David suggested that the fire department could use 500 ft. each of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  and  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " hose. Ald. King said he would like to check on this before placing an order for the hose.
5. Ald. King reported that two prisoners had managed to escape the city jail and had not been apprehended as of this date.
6. Supt. Owens told council that the city janitor, Byrom Denmon, had asked for extra pay in lieu of a vacation. Council agreed to give him \$12.50.
7. Supt. Owens advised council that the new lights and poles for the high school football field had been installed, the paving of Hunt subdivision completed and the sewerage there should be finished in about two weeks.
8. Supt. Owens reported that a control valve for the Brogdon Mt. reservoir had been ordered at a cost of about \$1,000.
9. Ald. Woods asked about the clear well at the old water plant. He said the leak should be stopped.
10. Ald. King made a motion that Police Chief Luther Roberts' salary be increased to \$450 per month and Fire Chief Hyde's salary be upped to \$400 per month. Ald. David seconded, voted and passed.
11. Ald. Norton moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. Woods and done.
