


SEPT. 13, 1965 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance read the 10th Psalm and opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of the Aug. 23 meeting read and approved.
3. Miss Mary Johnson complained of cooking odors, rats and paper emanating from Griffin's Drive In next door to her home. Miss Johnson said she had paid a pest control company to rid her property of rats which came from Griffin's place. Council advised Miss Johnson that Ald. David and Supt. Owens would see Mr. Griffin and induce him to take corrective action.
4. Supt. Owens informed the council that Janyjo, Inc. was planning to install a laundry and he was attempting to get Drs. Purcell and Thompson to permit the city to cross their property with the waste water to the creek.
5. Supt. Owens said he had found it necessary to contract the laying of some 2" water mains since there was so much more to do than could be done with city employees. Mr. Owens reported that the contractor was laying the mains for 50¢ per foot. Council approved.
6. Supt. Owens said Mr. James P. Beamer had requested a 3 months rate for his gin. No action taken.
7. Mr. C. M. Hatton asked council to extend water main to intersection of I-75 and SR 53 for a proposed service station. Supt. Owens to estimate cost and set minimum and advise Mr. Hatton.
8. Ald. Woods inquired as to status of the proposed water main extension from Peters St. to I-75. Supt. Owens said he had not been able to get to this job yet.
9. Ald. David heard in regard to airport, letter from FAA read and letter from Mr. Ed. Lacey asking that the name of the airport be left for local citizens to decide and also that cost of additional 400 ft. of runway be ascertained so that it might be paid for by donations.
10. Council said Monday, Sept. 20 at 7 PM would be tax "Gripe Night".
11. Ald. Norton moved the meeting be adjourned, Ald. Woods seconded and the meeting was adjourned.
