

FEB. 8, 1965 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT
EXCEPT ALD. J. T. WOODS, JR.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of the Jan. 25 meeting were read and approved.
3. Delegation from Echota Baptist Church was present with two petitions, one signed by adult members of the church and the other signed by neighbors in the vicinity of Mr. J. C. Kay's establishment for which he seeks a package malt beverage license. The pastor of Echota Baptist, Rev. John O'Neal and several members, including Raymond Ralston, Doyle Pruitt, Jack Morris and Carl Balliew requested council to deny Mr. Kay's request for a license. During the discussion, it was discovered that there was a discrepancy between the police department's and the church representatives' figures as to the distance between Mr. Kay's place and the church. The council meeting was temporarily adjourned at Ald. King's request in order that the figures might be checked. After substantiating the accuracy of the policemen's measurement, council went into executive session, ~~at~~ at the request of Ald. ~~King~~ ^{DAVID}. Upon resumption of the open meeting, Ald. King stated that since there was so much opposition to Mr. Kay's license, he recommended and moved that the council deny Mr. Kay's license request. Ald. David seconded and the motion passed 3-0.
4. Ald. David said he was considering installing storm sewer from his driveway on Line St. to the existing sewer at intersection of Line and Boulevard Heights.
5. Ald. King made a motion to employ an additional fireman, thereby relieving the fire chief of regular fireman's duties. Ald. David seconded the motion which was voted on and passed.
6. Ald. King moved that the county not be permitted to have radios on city frequency; seconded by Ald. Norton and passed.
7. Ald. King's motion that the City Board of Education be allowed to erect a building at the northwest corner of Pine and Fair Streets received a second from Ald. David and passed.
8. Ald. David heard in regard to the sewer service charge as to industry. It was decided to have Bill Greene, consulting engineer, here and to notify industries affected by this levy so that they might be present.
9. Letter from Eric Hill Associates read in regard to SR 25.
10. Ald. David moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. Norton and done.
