MARCH 8, 1965 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Mr. Bert Lance opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of Feb. 22 meeting were read and approved.
3. Ald. King reported that he had agreed for Gordon County to install radios on the city's frequency, but only in the cars of the sheriff and county commissioner.
4. Mr. Frank Hardwick, representing Franklin Life Insurance Co., presented a retirement plan for city employees. Mayor Dickinson appointed a committee of three, Ald. David and Norton and the city clerk, to study the plan or any other plan that they can recommend.
5. Ald. Woods heard in regard to extending water mains to the property of F. B. Shepherd et al.
6. Ald. Woods said he thought the city should consider an increase in water rates outside the corporate limits.
7. Ald. Woods asked Chief Roberts to stop trucks hauling garbage to the city dump in instances where they were littering the streets.
8. Supt. Owens said that residents of Hill City had requested city water and he was investigating the possibility of extending service mains to them.
9. Supt. Owens heard in regard to the Senior Citizens Club using the Civic Center for their meetings. Council agreed not to make any charge for their use of the facility.
10. Clerk read application of Mr. J. C. Kay for a package beer license and Mr. Dewitt Carter for regular license, both at N. Wall St. locations.
11. Albert W. Head was appointed to the Calhoun-Gordon County Planning Commission to replace Mr. J. L. Spink who resigned.
12. Supt. Owens estimated the cost of lighting the baseball field at Stephens School at \$2,000.
13. Ald. Norton made a motion to adjourn, Ald. Woods seconded and the meeting was adjourned.
