

JUNE 28, 1965 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL MEMBERS

PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of June 14 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Woods reported that the standpipe at Plainville had been repaired.
4. Supt. Owens advised council that the concrete alone would cost more than the amount allocated for the wading pool at Stephens School. Ald. David made a motion, seconded by Ald. King, to construct the wading pool. The motion was unanimously adopted. (Cost of concrete estimated at \$350.)
5. Supt. Owens said he attended a meeting in the office of Co. Comm. Everett DeFoor and that he expected Mr. DeFoor to sign a contract with Hunnicutt and Assoc. for \$93,200 for tax evaluation study for Gordon County. The completion date to be August 31, 1966.
6. Ald. Woods moved that the water line on Beamer Road be installed according to priority (date of acceptance by council). Ald. David seconded and the motion carried.
7. Supt. Owens told council that Reliable Insurance questioned the sewer service charge imposed on their office since they used a lavatory only. Council said anyone using the sewer system would have to pay the fee.
8. Supt. Owens said some of the hatcheries dumping eggs at the city dump would not cover the eggs after dumping. Mr. Owens stated that the city went to considerable lengths to provide these firms with this facility and was really under no obligation to do so since they were located outside the city limits. Council instructed Mr. Owens to stop the offending firms from dumping eggs at the city dump.
9. Supt. Owens said Mr. Harvey Combs dba Combs Funeral Home had requested a new curb in front of his place. Mr. Owens said the street should be widened there and the grass strip between the curb and sidewalk was sufficient to allow this. Council decided Mr. Owens should discuss this with Mr. Combs and advise.
10. Supt. Owens received council's permission to remove a tree on the west side of Piedmont St. near Line St. (At rear of H. J. Combs residence.)
11. Supt. Owens advised council that he would take his vacation beginning July 3.
12. New traffic lights discussed but action postponed.
13. Supt. Owens heard in regard to sewer at Astro Dye Works. Mr. Owens said Astro was expanding and had requested the city to lower its sewer main in order to provide Astro with sufficient fall. Mr. Owens stated that the city had lowered its main for a previous expansion and that the company or the contractor had made an error of one foot during the installation of their lines and this error would necessitate another lowering of the city's main. Mr. Owens said the city should not have to bear the expense of lowering this main again. Council took the matter under advisement.
14. Mr. James Keene was re-appointed to the Housing Authority of the City of Calhoun for an additional five year term ending July 16, 1970.
15. Ald. David moved to adjourn, Ald. King seconded and the meeting was adjourned.
