

JAN. 25, 1965 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL MEMBERS  
PRESENT EXCEPT ALD. WOODS

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of Jan. 25 meeting read and approved.
3. Ald. Norton requested that a center line be painted on Line St. from Boulevard Heights intersection to the city limits.
4. Ald. King said he wanted to see the sidewalk from Wade Motor Co. north to Wood-Brown Barber Shop clearly defined by painted lines or other means, so that parking on the sidewalk could be stopped.
5. Ald. David received council approval for two to attend the Civil Defense Seminar in Mobile, Ala. on Feb. 18,19,20.
6. Ald. David heard in regard to lighting the tennis courts. Council decided to postpone.
7. The application of Mr. J. C. Kay, Sr. for a package beer license on N. Wall St. was read.
8. Ald. King made a motion to grant 5% pay increases to all city employees effective Jan. 4, 1965. Ald. David seconded the motion which was passed unanimously.
9. Council agreed to buy a used Model 47 Thermo Fax copying machine from Merrill Dobbs for \$180.00.
10. Supt. Owens advised council that Co. Comm. Everett DeFoor wanted a radio on the city's frequency. Ald. King said he'd prefer to investigate this before deciding.
11. Supt. Owens said two ballasts at the Gordon Hills Shopping Center had been replaced for the second time due to improper installation by the contractor. The company (manufacturer) replaced the first two free of charge as defective, but they charged the city \$180 for the last two. Council instructed clerk to bill shopping center owners for this amount.
12. Supt. Owens said he had hired a janitor for the Civic Center Bldg. for \$25 monthly for two cleaning jobs per week.
13. Supt. Owens heard in the matter of Beamer Gin's electric bill. Council decided the 6 months minimum according to the contract for gins should be paid by Mr. Beamer.
14. Council approved payment of the 25¢ per electric meter assessed by the Power Section of the Georgia Municipal Assn. to defray cost of legal and engineering assistance required to remain a party to the FPC's show cause order to the Georgia Power Co.
15. Ald. David moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. King and so ordered by Mayor Dickinson.
