

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with scripture reading and prayer.
2. Minutes of Nov. 8 meeting read and approved.
3. Bill Ray and Sala Weaver present and wanting to know when and if water would be extended to them on the Herrington Bend Road. Council advised it would be several months before the line could be installed.
4. Ald. David made a motion that the City agree to pay \$25,000.00 or one fourth of the cost of a new library with the county to match this amount and the federal government to pay half. Mr. David said it would probably be about two years before the money was needed. Ald. King seconded the motion, which was voted on and passed.
5. Ald. Woods said the Gordon Hills Shopping Center merchants had requested the City to erect and decorate a Christmas tree and string some lights across the entrance. Mr. Woods moved that this be done. Ald. David seconded and the motion passed.
6. Ald. King's motion that City employees be given the same Christmas bonus as in prior years was seconded by Ald. Woods and passed.
7. Supt. Owens announced that there would be a power outage from 7 AM to 8 AM on Sunday, Nov. 28 so the Georgia Power Co. could install switches at Sub-station #1.
8. Council ordered City Hall closed for Christmas holidays at noon on Dec. 24 and re-opened on Dec. 27.
9. Ald. King moved to adjourn; Ald. David seconded and done.
