


MAY 10, 1965 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance called on Mr. Bill Mathews for the scripture reading. Dr. Lance then gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the regular meeting of April 26 and the called meeting of May 3 read and approved.
3. Two representatives of the American Family Life Assurance co. of Columbus, Ga. received permission from council to contact city employees, while off duty, in an effort to sell cancer insurance. (Group rate \$2.00 quarter for employees and \$3.75 per quarter for employee and family.)
4. Ald. King offered a motion that employees be granted one week vacation (with pay) after one year of service, one week, three days after five years and two weeks after ten years. Ald. David seconded and the motion passed unanimously.
5. Clerk was instructed to notify Mr. Robert Acree to repair or remove his building at the corner of Hicks St. and Park Avenue and his house at Oothcaloga and Fair Sts.
6. Members of the City Board of Education advised council that an additional \$13,500 was needed to complete their building program which includes remodeling of the gym, converting present library into two classrooms, new library and two new classrooms. Ald. Norton moved that the city furnish this amount when needed by the board; Ald. King seconded and the motion was approved.
7. Ald. King moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. David and done.
