

JULY 12, 1965 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with prayer.
2. Minutes of the June 28 meeting read and approved.
3. Mr. Paul J. Smith, Pres. of Astro Dye Works, told council that his company was expanding their facilities and would need the sewer main lowered one foot in order to accommodate this expansion. Mr. Smith was advised that City Supt. James Owens, on vacation, would meet with him on Wed., July 21 to work out a solution to this problem.
4. Mayor Dickinson announced that the city and county had agreed to cooperate in the handling of the dumping of eggs in the city dump.
5. Ald. Woods heard in regard to water taps for the new housing project. Water & Light Supt. Jack Bell said there were 50 water taps, one sewer tap, two man holes and two fire hydrants involved. Tom Shanahan, chairman of the housing authority to be contacted to determine if the housing authority or the contractor is to pay for this.
6. Ald. David said Mr. F. B. Shepherd had asked when the water main would be extended on Old Fairmount Highway. Mr. Bell said the city could not remove the old line because of construction at the present time.
7. Ald. David asked when sanitary sewer service would be available to Clifford W. Smith's residence on Buena Vista Rd. Mr. Bell said they were trying to complete the Hunt Subdivision sewer lines at the present.
8. Ald. David said he had been told that Mr. Vern Kuhlman had apparently made no effort to erect a fence around the swimming pool at his residence. Clerk to write Mr. Kuhlman.
9. Ald. David said the recreation comm. was planning to buy 35 acres of land from the Oothcaloga Industrial Development and asked if the city had any objections. Council approved so long as there is no cost to the city.
10. Mrs. Della Warren, dba Della's Restaurant, presented a petition with 42 signatures requesting the city to make a parking lot in the men's park. Mr. J. B. Langford, L & N attorney, to be contacted to see if the railroad would approve.
11. It was announced that Recorder's Court would be held on Tuesday at 5 P. M. from July 20 thru Sept.
12. W & L Supt. Jack Bell told council that the Stephens School swimming pool operator had made a practice of overflowing the pool and that the recreation commission had been advised and had agreed to stop this practice.
13. The clerk announced that the annual meeting of the Coosa Valley Area Planning & Development Commission would be held July 15 at Berry Schools.
14. Ald. Norton moved to adjourn, seconded by Ald. Woods and done.
