


AUGUST 11, 1969 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T.J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the called meeting of July 24 and the regular meeting of July 28 were read and approved.
3. Mayor Dickinson advised the delegation appearing in opposition to the issuance of a malt beverage package license to John H. Slagle that they would be notified prior to the meeting the license application is to be considered.
4. Mayor Dickinson promised another group that they would be given advance notice when the property known as the "Wise Estate" is to be voted on for annexation to the city.
5. Aldermen David and Holland and City Supt. Owens were appointed by the mayor as a committee to meet with J.T. Acree, Dick Inman, et al. here on Monday, August 18 at 7:30 PM to discuss their street problem.
6. Ald. David said that the 10 T Hangars proposed for construction at the airport would cost about \$30,000.00 and the plant mixed taxi strip an additional \$5,000.00. Mr. David stated that Comm. DeFoor had agreed to the county's half and made a motion that Mayor Dickinson be authorized to borrow \$17,500.00 in order for these additions to be made. Ald. Holland seconded the motion and it was approved.
7. Supt. Owens reported that the State Highway Dept. had requested Council approval to close a section of Oothcaloga St. to traffic for some six months during construction to widen the bridge over Oothcaloga Creek. After discussion, Ald. Holland moved that the Highway Dept. be notified that the city council wished the street left open to traffic during construction; 2nd by Ald. Woods, voted on and passed.
8. Supt. Owens said that the requested extension of the water main along S-1800 would cost approximately \$38,000.00, which would require a monthly minimum of \$10.50 from the 22 users.
9. The petitions for annexation of Marvin Dixon and William F. Frix, Jr. were accepted on motion of Ald. David, 2nd of Ald. Cox.
10. Council asked the clerk to have the total of the 1969 tax digest to present at the Aug. 25 meeting.
11. Council instructed the clerk to continue to charge service stations and car wash locations with the regular commercial sewer service charge.
12. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Holland and done.
