PRESENT.

Members of the Calhoun Recreation Commission were present to discuss with the Council the plans for the development of the new recreation area and the possibility of obtaining federal funds.


Mrs. Edna S. Langford, commission chairman, explained the proposed development and outlined the procedures for procuring matching funds from the Bureau of Outdoor Recreation.

After discussing the proposition, the motion was duly made by Alderman Tom B. David that the Calhoun Recreation Commission, by and through its chairman, Mrs. Edna S. Langford, be authorized to apply to the Bureau of Outdoor Recreation for \$283, 566.00 in matching funds. Alderman Jack Holland seconded the motion and it was adopted by unanimous vote.


The City Council agreed that the city will have available from bond funds, force account and cash its share of funds necessary to complete each phase of the project.
