

SEPT. 22, 1969 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Reverend Clinton Busler delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of the Sept. 8 meeting were read and approved.
3. Petitions in opposition to the issuance of a package malt beverage license to John H. Slagle at US 41 and SR 53 were presented by Howard Robinson for members of Belmont Baptist Church and by Rev. Clinton Busler for Nellie Peters Methodist Church. Others present and speaking against the license were Blake Putnam, Joyce Weir, Hill Fox, G. W. Edwards, Jr., Clarence Garren and Alton Dempsey. Ald. David moved that the application of Mr. Slagle be rejected, but received no second. Mayor Dickinson then asked if there was a motion to grant the license. The mayor then declared that the license would not be issued.
4. Ald. Holland said the JC's had requested permission for a one day animal circus. Council refused to grant the permit.
5. Ald. Holland heard with reference to increasing water rates inside and outside the city limits. No action taken.
6. Ald. David expressed a desire to see Calhoun participate in the Certified Cities Program.
7. Supt. Owens presented sample copies of contracts to be entered into with the companies on Industrial Blvd. seeking sewer service from the city. Ald. David moved that the contracts be approved as to form; Ald. Woods seconded, and the motion was approved.
8. Supt. Owens received approval to extend the sanitary sewer main to Stuckey's at I-75 & Red Bud Rd. provided they pay the cost and annex their property to the city. This done on motion of Ald. Woods, 2nd of Ald. Holland.
9. Supt. Owens said the State Highway Dept. wished to let the prime contractor on Oothcaloga St. project have the sewer contract also. Council agreed.
10. Forest Holsomback complained of surface water from the street running onto his property. Ald. Holland and St. Supt. Kirby to look into the matter.
11. Ald. David moved to adjourn; 2nd by Ald. Holland and done.
