

MARCH 10, 1969 - REGULAR MEETING CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR DICKINSON,  
ALD. DAVID, HOLLAND AND WOODS PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with scripture reading and prayer.
2. Minutes of Feb. 24 meeting read and approved.
3. Richard Mitzelfelt, Gordon Co. Sanitarian, said he had been requested to appear before the Council to protest the garbage and litter falling from trucks en route to the dump. He stated that the Co. Board of Health intended to pass an ordinance requiring covers on all vehicles transporting garbage.
4. Council discussed the problem of packs of wild dogs.
5. Supt. Owens requested and received permission to send Jack Bell and M. J. West to the Electric Meter School in Gainesville, Fla. ; April 14 to 18.
6. Council discussed the upcoming construction of a sewage treatment plant and the possibility of an increase in the sewer service charge to large users.
7. Clerk read card of thanks from Congressman John W. Davis.
8. Clerk read letter from Calhoun Housing Development Corp. agreeing to accept all city utilities and to annex their property upon request.
9. Water & Light Supt. Jack Bell and the clerk gave a brief report on the Atlanta meeting of the Power Section of the GMA, Mar. 5.
10. Mayor Dickinson briefed the Board of Aldermen on the ambulance service meetings he and Co. Comm. DeFoor have had with the local funeral directors.
11. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Woods and done.


