

AUGUST 25, 1969 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.


1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with the reading of an article from the Atlanta Constitution by the Rev. Billy Graham.
2. Minutes of the August 11 meeting were read and approved.
3. John Slagle asked Council to accept his petition for annexation of 8 lots constituting the north half of the Wise Estate property south of Hillcrest and east of Victory Drive. Ald. David moved that this property be annexed to the city and zoned R-1. Ald. Holland seconded and the motion was approved.
4. Ald. David moved that the city accept a deed from J. T. Acree to the South 60 ft. of Lot 11 of the Woodland Hills S/D and accept for annexation, zoned R-1, some 12 acres of land of said J. T. Acree and approximately 11 acres of land belonging to Irving Ostuw. The motion was seconded by Ald. Woods and approved with David and Woods for, Holland against and Cox not voting.
5. Ald. Woods offered a motion to increase water minimums to all customers outside the city by 50¢ per month effective with the October 5 billing; 2nd by Ald. David, voted on and passed.
6. Ald. Cox reported that Forrest Holsomback and Wayne Kuhlman had complained of surface water on their property since Dr. Edwin G. Brooks had installed concrete pipe along the front of his lot.
7. Council discussed the tax rate for 1969 and decided to set the millage rate at the September 8 meeting.
8. Ald. Cox moved that the property of J. Lawrence McBrayer and that of James B. Holland be accepted for annexation by petition of the owners; 2nd by Ald. Holland, voted on and passed.
9. Ald. Woods moved to adjourn; 2nd by Ald. David and done.
