


JULY 14, 1969 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT EX-
cept Alderman Woods.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance opened the meeting with the reading of Chap. 20 of the Book of Exodus.
2. Minutes of the June 23 meeting read and approved.
3. Otis Brown presented several contracts for water service near Resaca.
4. J. T. Acree asked Council to accept a deed to a portion of Lot 11 in the Woodland Hills S/D adjacent to the city sewerage pumping station and permit him to open a street to his property. Mr. Acree also petitioned to have a portion of his property annexed to the city. Council agreed to advise Mr. Acree at the July 28 meeting as to the re-location of the sewer line requested by him.
5. J. C. Boyd heard in regard to a sign at the Chicken Man Drive In Supt. Owens and Bldg. Insp. Bowman to handle.
6. Ald. Holland moved that James S. McClurd be granted a license for package malt beverage sales at Red Bud Road and Columbus Cir. Ald. Cox seconded the motion and he and Ald. Holland voted for issuance of the license, Ald. David against. Mayor Dickinson declared the motion was approved.
7. Ald. Holland asked about progress on the street to the new recreation area. Supt. Owens said one strip had been paved.
8. Ald. David made a motion that the new jail contract be accepted as proposed by the county. Ald. Holland 2nd, voted on and passed.
9. Supt. Owens announced that Arthur Pew Construction crews are here and ready to begin work on the sewer mains.
10. Water & Light Supt. Bell said the Georgia Power Co. had agreed to lend the city 2 breakers and 2 sets of regulators to help alleviate overloaded conditions at both sub-stations.
11. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Holland and done.
