



MARCH 24, 1969 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH MAYOR DICKINSON,  
ALDERMEN DAVID, HOLLAND AND WOODS PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of March 10 meeting read and approved.
3. Clinton E. Taylor, owner of Veteran Cab Co., asked permission to employ female drivers. The request was referred to Ald. David, Chairman of the Police Committee, and Chief Roberts.
4. Supt. Owens heard in the matter of acquiring easements for construction of sewerage facilities. Council instructed Mr. Owens to offer a maximum of 50¢ per foot.
5. Council approved the re-zoning of two parcels of land just off the Red Bud Road. Several lots south of Red Bud Rd. and west of Barrett Rd. changed from R-1 to C-2 classification and several lots north of Red Bud Rd. and west of New Town Rd. changed to R-2. Also re-zoned on motion of Ald. David and 2nd of Ald. Woods was the property bordered by Court, River, Line and King Sts. This was changed from residential to C-2.
6. The bid letting on the sewerage treatment plant and other improvements to the sewer system was announced for Tuesday, April 15 at 2:00 P. M.
7. Ald. David moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Holland and done.
