

JUNE 9, 1969 - REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.


1. In the absence of Chaplain Lance, Mayor Dickinson gave the invocation.
2. Minutes of the May 26 meeting were read and approved.
3. Council reviewed the proposal of Southeastern Consulting Engineers of Charlotte, N. C. for mapping and revamping the city's electrical system. Mayor Dickinson appointed Ald. Woods to study the offer of Southeastern with Supt. Owens and Water & Light Supt. Bell and report to the June 23 meeting.
4. Jack C. Knight explained to Council that he planned to have drive in service only with one way traffic from North to South if his application for a package malt beverage license on S. Wall St. is approved. Ald. David moved that the license be granted subject to the stated traffic condition; 2nd by Ald. Holland, voted on and passed with Ald. Woods abstaining.
5. Ald. Holland then made a motion that James S. McClurd be granted a package malt beverage license on Red Bud Road. Mayor Dickinson declared it no motion since it failed to get a second.
6. The annexation referendum was discussed with Ald. Woods moving that the date of the referendum be Wednesday, August 6, 1969. Ald. Holland seconded the motion; voted on and approved.
7. The parking lot between Court & Oothcaloga Sts., Park Avenue & the L & N RR was discussed with Supt. Owens estimating the lot would provide an additional 80 to 85 parking spaces.
8. John Michael Dobson, of a Peters St. address, was present to appeal Recorder's Court Case No. 427 of June 4, 1969 in which Mr. Dobson was charged with running two traffic lights at Wall and Court Sts., found guilty as charged and fined \$18.00. After hearing Mr. Dobson's testimony, Council heard his companion, one Stanley Chambers, corroborate Mr. Dobson's version, then heard Police Officer Billy Mincey contradict that testimony. Ald. Woods moved that the verdict of Mayor Dickinson in Recorder's Court be upheld, but that the fine be reduced to \$12.00. Ald. Holland 2nd the motion, which was voted on and passed.
9. Ald. Woods moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Cox and done.
