



JULY 28, 1969-REGULAR MEETING OF CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Minutes of July 14 meeting read and approved.
3. Mr. J. T. Acree was advised by Supt. Owens that the contractor's superintendent was on vacation and the re-location of the sewer line across Mr. Acree's property would have to await his return.
4. Ald. David moved that the city purchase a new console (base station) radio for the Police Dept. Ald. Holland seconded and the motion was approved.
5. Ald. David heard in reference to a complaint from S. M. Harrison that his water was "muddy" and the volume was inadequate. Water and Light Supt. Jack Bell explained that the "muddy" water is probably due to reversing the flow in the main caused by an increase in the pressure when the pump was switched at the filter plant. Mr. Bell stated that Mr. Harrison would probably have to enlarge the service line from the main to his house to realize any appreciable improvement in the volume of water received.
6. John Slagle's application for a package malt beverage license at the SE corner of US 41 and SR 53 was postponed.
7. Ald. Woods advised that a dead tree in the triangle of city land north of Meadowbrook Dairy should be cut.
8. Ald. Woods said the owner should be instructed to remove the dirt obstructing the sidewalk on S. Wall St. Supt. Owens to handle.
9. Ald. Holland inquired as to progress on the cable TV installation. Supt. Owens said Mr. Stocks advised that the work was proceeding as rapidly as possible.
10. Council discussed the annexation referendum to be held on Wednesday, August 6 and agreed to notify the public that a garbage collection fee of \$2.00 per month would be charged residences that do not use city power.
11. Mr. J. C. Boyd said the large drainage ditch on the west side of the city needed cleaning. Supt. Owens to take care of this.
12. W & L Supt. Bell announced that the Georgia Power Co. had delivered the breakers and switches to improve the power output at sub station #2.
13. Ald. David moved to adjourn; 2nd by Ald. Woods and done.
