



JAN. 13, 1969 - REGULAR MEETING CITY COUNCIL WITH ALL PRESENT.

1. Chaplain T. J. Lance delivered the invocation.
2. Mayor Dickinson administered the oath of office to re-elected Aldermen Tom B. David and John T. Woods, Jr. and newly elected Alderman Jerry J. Clark.
3. Minutes of regular meeting of Dec. 9 and called meeting of Dec. 30 read and approved.
4. Results of City Election of Dec. 11 announced and spread on the minutes of this session.
5. On motion of Ald. David, with a second from Ald. Holland, Tom L. Shanahan was re-appointed city attorney.
6. Ald. Holland moved and Ald. Woods 2nd, that Ald. Tom B. David be named Mayor Pro Tem for 1969; voted on and passed.
7. Mayor Dickinson said the same men would serve as committee chairmen for the ensuing year with Ald. Clark taking former Ald. Head's appointments.
8. All department heads were re-appointed on motion of Ald. David with second from Ald. Woods.
9. Ald. David read a proposal for a cable TV franchise from United Artists Theater Circuit of Dallas, Texas. It was referred to the committee.
10. Ald. David said he believed he had finally pacified the FAA with regard to the spur track to the Goodyear property.
11. Bob O'Connor, acting as spokesman for some 20 residents in the neighborhood, protested the re-zoning of several lots in Spring Acres Subdivision. Ald. Woods moved that the property remain as zoned, R-1; Ald. Holland 2nd and the motion was approved without a dissenting vote.
12. Clerk read application of Otis Garren for a package malt beverage license on Red Bud Road at Columbus Circle. Referred to Ald. Clark, chairman of the license committee.
13. Pay increase for city employees discussed and postponed until next meeting.
14. Discussion of budget with adoption scheduled at a subsequent meeting.
15. Supt. Owens heard with reference to pay for volunteer firemen. Mayor Dickinson suggested that Mr. Owens, Chief Hydemand Ald. David resolve the problem.
16. Ald. David moved to pay the '69 GMA dues of \$487.51. 2nd by Ald. Holland, voted on and passed.
17. Ald. David moved to accept the property of Jack E. Fain and L. D. "Buddy" Bryant on petition for annexation. 2nd by Ald. Holland and approved.
18. Ald. Woods said he appreciated the opportunity to serve two more years as an alderman and expressed appreciation for the cooperation of the dept. heads and other employees. Mr. Woods said the garbage dump was in good shape, but streets were still being littered enroute to the dump.
19. Supt. Owens said the L & N had advised that a contract for the proposed parking lot east of the depot would be ready for signing on Jan. 17.
20. Ald. Woods moved to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. David and done.
