

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and Chaplin John Allen gave the invocation.
2. The minutes of the Aug. 11, 1975, meeting were read and approved.
3. Public Comments: (1) Lonnie Daniel of Hunt's Drive submitted a signed petition for repaving of the streets in Hunt's Subdivision. Mayor Burdette thanked the group for their request and stated that a contract for paving of Hunt's Drive had been signed and the work should begin in a few weeks.
(2) Jack Stepp requested the City's assistance in changing out 600 ft. of 2 inch water line for a 6 inch line and 450 ft. of a 2 inch line for a 4 inch line in Echota Acres Subdivision. He had visited the State Water Supply Section of the Dept. of Natural Resources for their approval. He also requested permission to use PVC pipe in the subdivision. He agreed to purchase all the pipe for new lines provided the City would install at no charge. There would be no rebate on future taps. After discussion, a motion was made by Ald. Padgett to approve the request, 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.
(3) Glenn Elder representing the stadium committee requested the City's approval to have a referendum for \$750,000.00 of general obligation bonds to build a new stadium, improve the civic auditorium, cover the school swimming pool, install all weather surfaces on the track and tennis courts, improve the field and seating of the baseball field and install a new roof on the Line Street Gym. After general discussion Ald. Collins made the motion to place the referendum on the Nov. 19th Municipal Election ballot, 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.
(4) Mr. Dalton Byerly presented his report on the Calhoun Rabies Control Center and make several recommendations, as per the attached report. Ald. Cox made the motion to build an overhanging roof over the runs and prepare cost estimates on a C.O. chamber, 2nd by Ald. Padgett and approved.
4. Old Business: (1) Ald. Padgett made the motion to approve water taps for Ralph Dixon off the Dews Pond Road; Gordon Mize on the Red Bud Road; Calvin Cross lot 14 of Amakanata Subdivision and Terry Poarch off the Moose Club Road. 2nd by Ald. Lewis and approved.
(2) The Clerk reported that the deed to the Post Office had been recorded and as of Aug. 25, 1975, the City has possession of the property. The Clerk and Asst. Manager Roy Fox explained the preliminary drawings for the floor plan. Mayor Burdette stated that a qualified carpenter would be hired to oversee the project.

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(3) Asst. Manager Roy Fox stated that the Meadow Lane curb and gutter should be finished within a few days.


(4) Electric Supt. Jack Bell discussed the recent study by Southeastern Consultants. The Council proposed that Supt. Bell follow the study's outline using his own equipment and men to do as much of the work as possible.

5. New Business: (1) Annexation petitions for Doyle Phillips and James Holland's Duffey Motel North were presented. Since the annexation could not be effective until the first of 1976, the Council asked that these be tabled until the next meeting.

(2) Ald. Collins made the motion to pave the back of the Community Center provided the County agrees to pay half the cost, 2nd by Ald. Cox and approved.

6. Ald. Padgett made the motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Collins and approved.
