

1. Mayor Burdette called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.
2. The minutes of the November 24, 1975, meeting were read. The date of the Electric Meeting originally scheduled for Dec. 1, at 6:00 p.m. this change being noted the minutes were approved.
3. Mayor's Comments: Mayor Burdette stated that the Motorcade to Milledgeville would take place on Dec. 10 and any of the Councilmen were welcome to attend.

A meeting scheduled at City Hall on Dec. 9 at 3:00 p.m. with David Bowers of Coosa Valley concerning the 208 Land Use Control Program.

Mayor Burdette presented an award to Rep. Tom Shanahan from GMA for outstanding contributions to the Cities of Georgia. The award was to have been presented at the annual convention, but a special legislative session was scheduled for this time.

4. Public Comments: Clifford Free of Combs, Jennings, and Free Funeral Home requested the City's permission and assistance to remove four large trees that could possibly be hazardous to their business. Mrs. Free stated that if the trees could be moved, they would be replaced with small trees such as dogwoods and etc. Mayor Burdette asked the City Manager and the Electrical Superintendent to check the site and report their findings to the Dec. 22 meeting.
5. New Business: (a) Fire Chief Grizzle reported that Bill Wilson of Insurance Services from the Nashville office made the survey last week as we had requested earlier. The results should be forthcoming from the Atlanta Office within the next two weeks. (b) The Clerk presented the annual audit report to each Council member, with the request that these be studied during the next two weeks. Any questions or comments can be made at the Dec. 22 meeting or to the Clerk or auditor during the two weeks period. (c) Bids were presented on a cash register for the drive-in window at the new office. N.C.R.'s bid was \$1427.00 and Calhoun Office Supply's bid was \$1045.00. Ald. Lewis made a motion to accept the low bid of \$1045.00 from Calhoun Office Supply, 2nd by Ald. Padgett and approved. (d) The City Clerk read changes in the proposed Personnel Ordinance read at an earlier meeting. Copies are to be distributed to the Councilmen and voted on at the Dec. 22 meeting.
6. Old Business: (a) Bids were opened on a new flat bed truck for the Street Dept.:
 - 1 - Prater Ford 1976 F-700 with specified equipment \$7,246.00
 - 2 - Roy Davis Chev. 1976 Chevrolet \$7,037.80City Engineer Hobgood stated that there was some difference in the two vehicles and this should be taken into consideration. Mayor Burdette asked that no acceptance be made on the bids until Dec. 22, in order to allow Harold Kirby time to review each bid.

(b) No water tap requests.

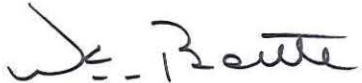
